

Other News.....

Holidays in Term Time

There have been some holiday requests from parents and Carers at both schools to take holidays during term time. Whilst I fully appreciate the need to do this - the increased Cost of holidays outside of term time, the restrictions on taking leave from work in term time - holidays during term time cannot be authorised absences as per the Department for Education Guidance. If you are planning a holiday, please speak to a member of the Admin Team and ask for a Holiday Request Form. This needs to be completed so that we are aware of the dates the children will be absent and the fact they are on holiday this is for safeguarding purposes.

Bank Holiday and Training Day

There is another Training Day on Friday May 25th when schools will be closed. This will be the final Training Day of the school year.

As well as the May Day Bank Holiday on Monday May 1st there will be an additional Bank Holiday for the Coronation on Monday May 8th. Both schools will be closed on these dates.

<u>Gaming</u>

We are still hearing from Children that they are accessing games and online Content that is above their age and that they are playing inappropriate games before and after school. You may have seen in the national press this last week about gaming and the effects that this Can have on Children in terms of their physical and mental health and general well-being. I would urge you to please be mindful of what games and Content your Child is able to access and play as well as the amount of screen time they have each day.
