PE Days and Kits


Forest School Days

On Forest School day (Thursday) children are to come to school in their uniform but ensuring that they have their arms and legs covered. As we move into Autumn and Winter, this shouldn't be a problem as the boys will be wearing trousers and jumpers and the girls wearing trousers or tights. Children may bring an extra sweatshirt/fleece to add as an extra layer when it is cold. They will also need a weather appropriate coat.

No jewellery is to be worn on PE, Forest School or swimming days. If children are able to take out and put back in earrings on their own they may do so. If they are not able to, they should not wear earrings to school on these days. Taping over earrings is not permitted.

EYFS have been working really hard to recognize sounds and letters this week! Nursery have been using instruments to recognize the different noises we can make and reception have been looking at their own names and the initial sound!



Our Learning This Week.....Class 1

This week in class 1, we have continued to develop our vocabulary and knowledge around sycamore trees in preparation for writing a non-fiction text, we became squirrels looking for nuts (facts) around the classroom which the children loved! We are doing lots of counting and looking at place value in Maths, and learning about seasons in science. The children worked hard in science lessons to make a beautiful seasons mobile.



Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

PE-this week the children have been learning the skills needed for tag rugby, they have shown excellent teamwork and resilience during these lessons.

Science-the children have become amazing scientists this week, learning all about the human body especially bones and what the skeletal system is needed for. We have looked at vertebrates and invertebrates and organised animals into their right categories.

The Children have worked really hard within their maths lessons building their knowledge based on place value.
