### Forest School Days

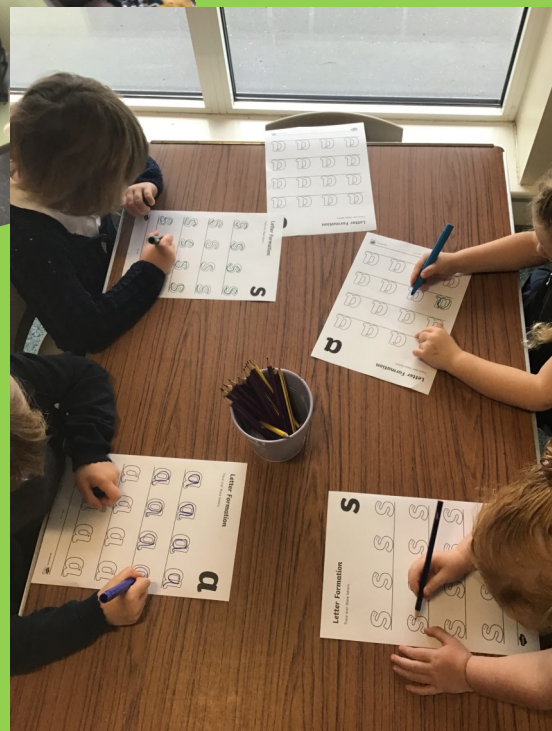
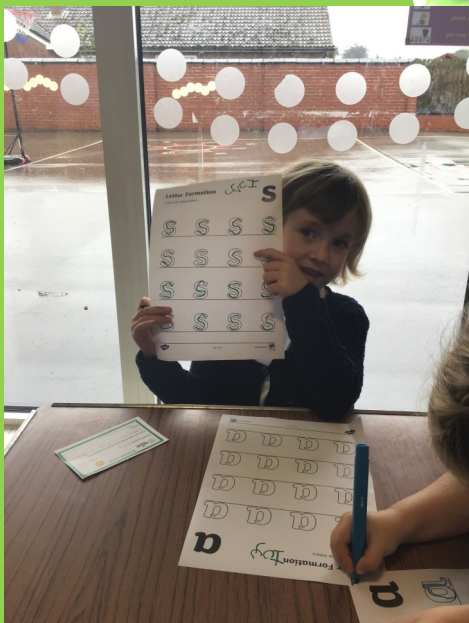
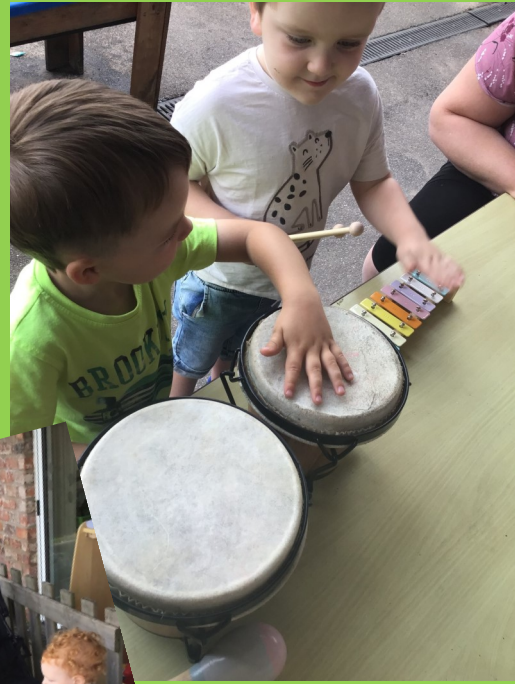
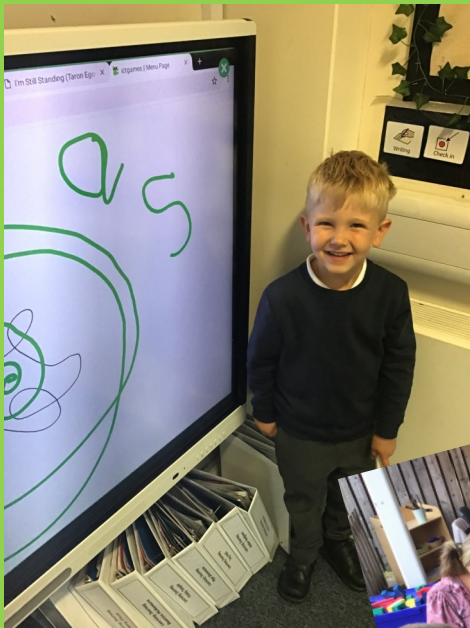

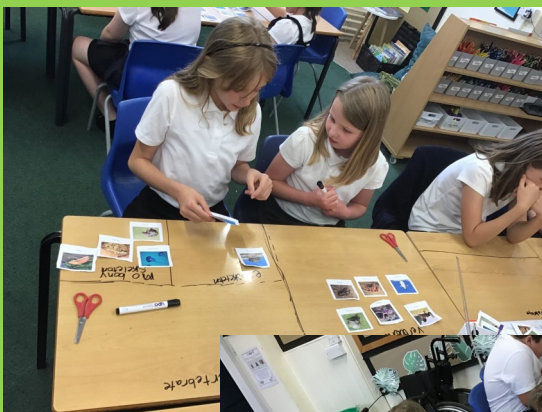


## Our Learning This Week.....Class 2
