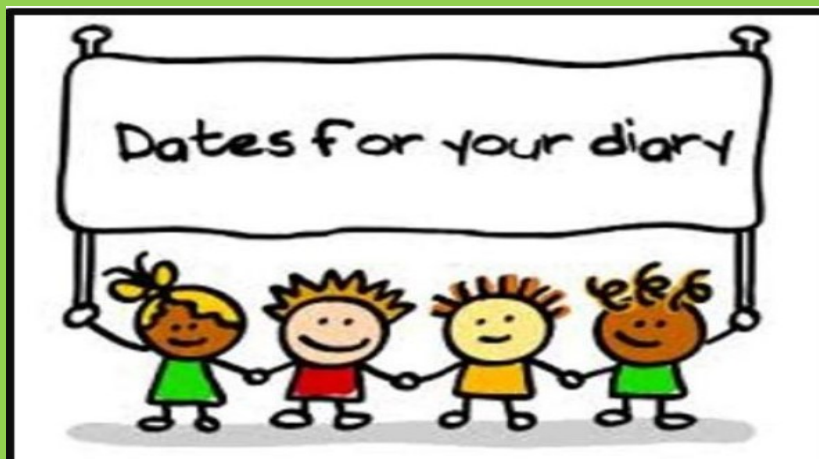

The children are really loving ICT at the moment and are starting to learn about programming using bee bots.



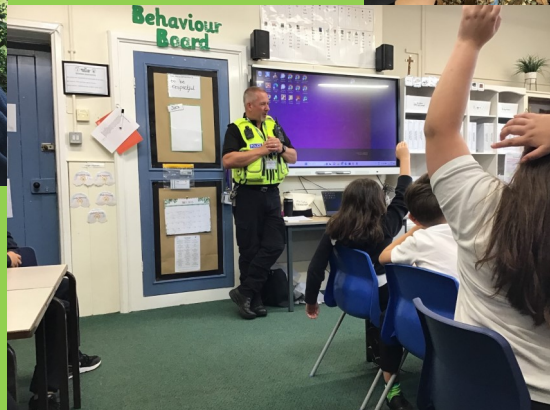
## Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

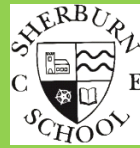
